The installation comprised of 12 sundials in a grid, each with an image set in the face pertaining to an hour of the sun lit day.


The companion prints are hand burnished wood block prints on mulberry paper, hand coloured with Winsor and Newton water colour.

This is a great opportunity to get original hand burnished wood block prints to decorate your home or office.


Framing need not be expensive, good frames can be sourced from many chain stores and your local framer can cut an acid free mount to fit, or simply get them to do the whole job.






NOON - Time is money
